Parents can view their child's report card in Focus by navigating to the **Reports** tab and selecting the Report Card file. See Figure 1.

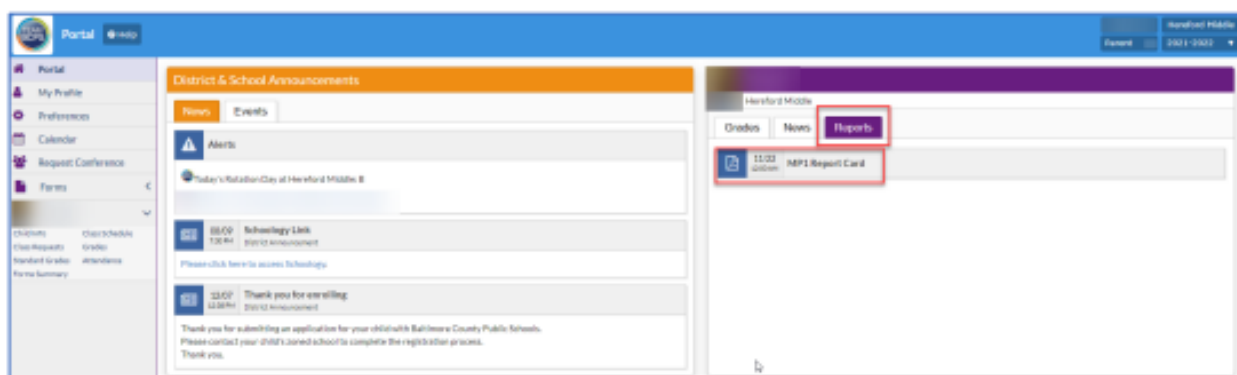

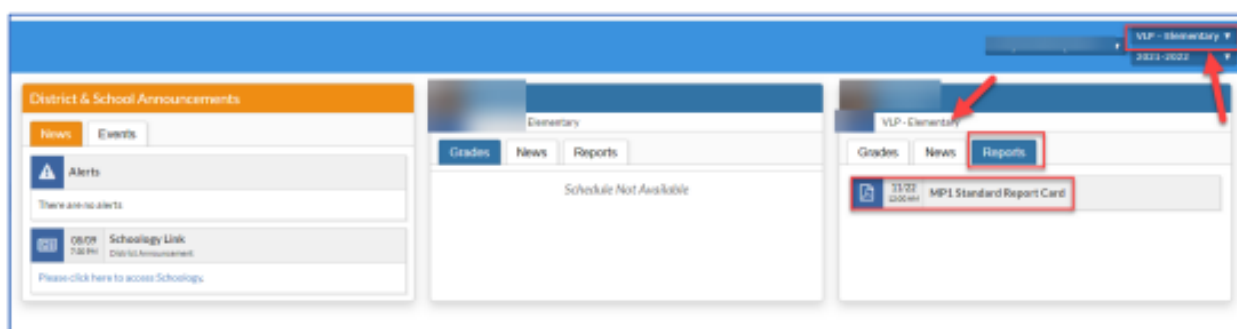
