Dear Parents,

We are thrilled to announce that Jacksonville's attendance for the first term was 98%. This was the highest percentage for all Zone 2 schools. With that said, if you drop your child off in the morning and the front doors are closed, your child is late. A parent must come in with the child to sign him/her in on the office clipboard. If your child goes straight to the room without being signed in, he/she could be marked absent for the entire day.

Also any time a child is absent, a signed note must accompany his/her return. Emails do not suffice for Board of Education Rule 5120:

II. Absences

- A. A student absent from school shall present a note immediately upon return to school.
 - 1. The note, signed by the parent/guardian, shall include the name of the student,
 - The date of, and the reason for the absence.
 - 2. Upon receipt of the absence note, the school will certify the absence as excused or unexcused.
 - 3. Absences not supported by a note will be considered unexcused and unlawful.



At this time of year, the office tends to receive numerous requests for transcripts to be sent to private schools. To help defray the cost of copying and postage, every request must be accompanied by \$5.00. Nothing will be sent until the payment is received. Please submit all requests and money to Mrs. O'Brien, the records secretary.

<u>Jacksonville Elementary 2013/2014</u> <u>Kindergarten Registration</u>



Jacksonville Elementary will be holding its 2013-2014 school year registration on Tuesday, March 19 and Wednesday, March 20, 2013. The appointment day and time will be assigned for your child. An informational packet will be mailed a few weeks before the registration date. This registration is intended for children who will be entering kindergarten in the fall, as well as children who are currently attending kindergarten in private schools but plan to enroll at Jacksonville Elementary for first grade for the 2013-2014 school year. Children entering kindergarten next year must be five years of age by September 1, 2013. Children entering first grade must be six years of age by September 1, 2013. Kindergarten will remain a full day program for the 2013-2014 school year.

If you will be registering your child or know someone who will be registering a child, please complete/have them complete this form and return it to the school office. Please do not contact the office regarding an appointment. A packet of information (including an appointment date & time) will be sent home approximately one month prior to the registration day. A letter will be enclosed outlining the items needed for the registration.
