

Jacksonville Elementary Reopening Information

Jacksonville Elementary's return to in person learning will focus on key mitigation strategies that include face coverings, social distancing, hand hygiene, cleaning and contact tracing. Our focus will continue to be on student growth paired with the social and emotional wellbeing of our students and staff. We will continue to provide high quality and rigorous academic instruction in the hybrid and virtual settings.

<p>Transportation:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Transportation information will be provided by BCPS and sent to families. 2. Buses will be at a limited capacity and with assigned seating on am and pm rides. 3. Masks will be required to be worn. 4. Students will enter the bus and walk to the back to be seated. The bus will be loaded from back to front. Upon arrival at school, children will exit the bus from front to back. Children will enter the front doors and walk to their classrooms. Siblings will not be permitted to walk younger children to their classrooms. 5. Dismissal will occur in the main halls. 1 bus at a time will be called. K and 1 students will walk down the hallway, 6 feet apart. They will be loaded prior to the grade 2-5 students who will wait single file 1 line, 6 feet apart. 6. All students will receive bus tags to indicate the Cohort letter and bus name. 	<p>Face Covering:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property. Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses. 2. Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged. <hr/> <p>Social Distancing:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-feet separation between students, when possible. 2. Reduce gathering of students in any area – refer to changes in arrival and dismissal procedures and movement in the hallway.
<p>Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All employees and students are expected to screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19. 2. Remain home if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results. 3. Parents will receive a screening checklist and magnet with the screening practices. 	<p>Breakfast & Lunch:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Breakfast will be grab and go from the front table in the main hallway as children enter the building. All breakfast meals will be eaten in the student classrooms. 2. Students will eat in the cafeteria by cohort at individual desks with spacing at least 6 feet apart. 3. The cafeteria will serve one grade level at a time seated in class cohorts.
<p>Hand Hygiene:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Times for handwashing or use of hand sanitizer to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools' offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and other time hands are contaminated. 	<p>Visitors:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment. 2. Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible. 3. If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face coverings and practice social distancing. 4. The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.
<p>Supplies & Devices:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Supply lists were provided to parents by School Messenger. They will also be available on the BCPS Jacksonville website. 2. Requests for devices in the classroom will be by teacher request. Please refer to your child's classroom teacher for information. 3. Teachers will avoid the use of shared supplies or materials. If used, items will be sanitized and cleaned between use. 	<p>School Schedules:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Jacksonville will maintain the appropriate times of the school day: 9:05 to 1:45 and 9:05 to 3:45. 2. The schedules will follow the BCPS and MSDE recommended classroom hours of instruction. 3. The master schedule will change. The schedule will include A and B weeks so that all children have the availability of "in-person" teaching in the special areas.
<p>School Specific Information:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parents who bring "late" forgotten items should place the item in the box outside, ring the bell, and speak to the front office staff. The staff will then retrieve the items after the parent has left. 	<p>Special Schedules:</p> <p>Week 1: attend classes as scheduled M-F - students attend special in-person if they are in school and virtually if they are not.</p>

	<p>Week 2: attend specials in this order - Thursday, Friday, Wednesday, Monday, Tuesday (so, on Monday, you will go to Thursday specials; on Tuesday go to Friday specials, etc.) (Wednesday classes will always be online.)</p> <p>Here is the schedule for 1/2 weeks:</p> <p>1 - weeks of 3/1, 3/15, 4/5, 4/19, 5/3, 5/17, 5/31, 6/14</p> <p>2 - weeks of 3/8, 3/22, 4/12, 4/26, 5/10, 5/24, 6/7, 6/21</p>
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
